

CAMPER PACKING LIST

Please remember to label all items with camper's name. It may be helpful to put a list of packed items inside your child's trunk/luggage so the he can check the items when packing at the end of the session.

Please keep in mind there is no need to purchase new clothing for Camp. **During the one week camp we will not be providing laundry service for campers so please pack enough for the entire week**.** Campers sometimes misplace their belongings, **therefore please mark all items sent with the child.**

Personal Items

sunscreen

soap and soap case
shampoo
brush/comb
toothbrush
reusable water bottle
toothpaste
deodorant
flashlight
batteries
stationary
stamps

Clothing

1 pairs of jeans or long pants

1 pair of shower shoes or flip flips
7 pairs of shorts
7 T-shirts
1 long sleeve shirt or sweatshirt

7 pairs of underwear
7 pairs of socks
2 pairs of shoes (no sandals)
2 bathing suits/swim trunks
2 sets of pajamas
1 hat

Other Items

4 towels (bathrobe if desired)
2 beach/lake towels
2 washcloths
1 sleeping bag
1 sets of sheets with pillow cases (optional)
1 laundry bag**
1 blanket
1 pillow
1 jacket or sweatshirt
1 rain coat or poncho
1 small overnight back pack (optional for campout night)

Optional Items: camera (disposable), bug spray, summer reading books, journal, case and safety strap for glasses, a small bucket or container to carry shower items., **battery operated fan.**

Items Not Allowed: Please do not bring: **Cell phone, i-pods, jewelry, TV, radio, handheld video games, electric fans, animals/pets, hair dryer, knives, candy, cokes or other valuables or personal sports equipment (waiver is required if a camper wants to bring equipment).** While some electronics have been allowed in the past they have come to be disruptive to the program. Camp Marymount reserves the right to search trunks, bags, and packages and to confiscate any of the above items and any items it deems dangerous or not appropriate for its program. We are not responsible for the condition or security of items confiscated, including cell phones and i-pods. **Camp Marymount, Inc. is not responsible for articles of property lost or stolen. Please do not bring items of monetary or sentimental value.** Camp Marymount discourages parents from sending money with their child and is not responsible for the loss of money even if kept in our safe.

**Laundry service is not offered for one week campers. We will offer laundry for campers staying the next two week session at the end of the one week session.
