Dear Parent,

I am writing you today because there has been a change in Camp Marymount's vaccination policy. The Board of Trust and our camp Doctor has approved the following policy, as it is also resembles the Nashville Catholic Diocese Diocesan Schools vaccination policy.

Campers must meet the immunization requirements for school-aged children laid out by the TN Department of Health. They need to be up-to-date on the following vaccinations, to include 7<sup>th</sup> grade Tdap boosters:

- \*measles, mumps, rubella
- \*varicella (or documented proof of previous chicken pox infection)
- \*tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis
- \*poliomyelitis
- \*hepatitis B

The Diocese of Nashville does not allow religious exemptions. The only exception is a *medical* exemption. *Medical* exemptions must be indicated on a state Certificate of Immunization or stated in a letter on letterhead from your primary doctor. One or the other is required.

The Certificate of Immunization is to be provided to Camp Marymount at least 1 week prior to the start of camp.
