

WHAT'S HAPPENING WEDNESDAY

Just some reminders regarding summer camp and our Marymount in May virtual auctions.

Please review our camp “forms” section of our website to make sure any forms that pertain to you get filled out and sent to camp via email (info@campmarymount.com) before camp starts. See below.

- If your child has underlying conditions, have the doctor release signed– IF THIS FORM IS RESTRICTED ON YOUR BROWSER, you can find it on our website under the COVID tab <http://www.campmarymount.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/04/Doctor-COVID-Release.pdf>
- If you cannot pick up your camper within 10 hours of a phone call from camp for COVID symptoms, have the form completed with the responsible party info – IF THIS FORM IS RESTRICTED ON YOUR BROWSER, you can find it on our website under the COVID tab <http://www.campmarymount.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/04/Pick-up-Responsibility-Form-COVID-19.pdf>
- If your camper takes medicines that are required while at camp have the doctor complete a script of some kind with the medicines and doses needed while at camp.
- **NEW:** If your camper has had **both vaccinations** at least 14 days prior to the start of camp, email the vaccination card. Additionally *IF your camper has had BOTH vaccinations AND at least 14 days prior to the start of their session – they will NOT need a COVID test*
- If your camper has dietary restrictions it needs to be completed on the camper account on the “camper medical information” form. The cost is \$25 per session for us to accommodate the restrictions of vegetarian, peanut allergy, gluten free or lactose free and must be completed on the medical form. We do not accommodate a camper’s request for dietary restrictions during the session. A parent must mark it on the medical form and pay in advance.
- As a reminder parents need to stay in their cars at check in. All the check-in requirements are found in the COVID handbook <http://www.campmarymount.com/wp-content/uploads/2021/04/2021-Policies-Procedures-Covid-Edition.pdf>
- As a continued reminder, we have changed our policy on the COVID test timeline. You have up to 7 days to have your child tested as opposed to the 4 as earlier stated. We do require a PCR test not a rapid test. No test needed if FULLY vaccinated 2 weeks before the start of camp.
