The following are required BEFORE check -in (email [info@campmarymount.com](mailto:info@campmarymount.com))

- Insurance card and immunizations (check the camper account to ensure received and processed, under "forms")
- Negative COVID test - dated *no earlier than 7 days before arrival*  
OR  
vaccination card to show *both* immunizations with the final vaccination being *no later than 14 days prior to arrival*.
- Tuition paid in full (check the camper account to verify)
- **\*\*If** your camper will NEED DAILY OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATION – doctor's note required stating the medicine is required while at camp, email [info@campmarymount.com](mailto:info@campmarymount.com)

- **\*\*If** your camper is under the care of a doctor – complete the “underlying conditions” form (COVID tab on website) – email [info@campmarymount.com](mailto:info@campmarymount.com)
- **\*\*If** parents will not be within 10 hours of camp – complete the “pick-up authorization” form (COVID tab on website) – email [info@campmarymount.com](mailto:info@campmarymount.com)

The following are required at check-in.

- 7-day temperature check sheet (found in the COVID handbook- this will severely delay check-in if not completed and turned in at check-in)
